

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 64-11, the Council denied Doy Reidhead on extension of time to complete the Becker Creek No. 1 Salvage Logging Unit, and

WHEREAS, said resolution instructed the Agency Forester to ascertain the amount of damages due the Tribe because of breach of contract, and

WHEREAS, the Agency Forester has advised the Tribe that there were no damages for a breach and requested the Tribe amend the said resolution by deleting the request that the Forester ascertain the amount of damages.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 64-11 is hereby amended by deleting in toto the second resolved clause therein.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
