WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribe has shown a great deal of interest in establishing a bank at Whiteriver, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has been negotiating with said banking people to establish said bank, and

WHEREAS, the Area Director has received assurance that the Guaranty Bank of Arizona would make an economic survey on the reservation to determine the feasibility for establishing a bank.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Area Director is hereby requested to authorize the said Guaranty Bank or any other bank to make a feasibility study on the reservation to determine the economic advisability of establishing a bank at Whiteriver.

The foregoing resolution was on February 5, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) & (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
