

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council do, due to industrial expansion is sorely in need of rent houses for the employees of said industries, and

WHEREAS, John W. Lee has two houses he is willing to sell to the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, Mike Palumbus has one house that he is willing to sell to the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman be and he is hereby authorized to purchase the two houses from Mr. John W. Lee and to bid therefor the appraisal value of same.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Chairman is hereby authorized to purchase the Mike Palumbus house and to pay for same a sum not to exceed \$5500.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sums necessary to purchase the above houses be budgeted in the 1964-65 Fiscal Year Budget and that the purchase not be made until after May 1, 1964.

The Foregoing resolution was on February 26, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, section 1 (a), (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
