

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**


WHEREAS, on the 16th day of January, 1963, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council adopted Ordinance No. 47 establishing a Housing Authority on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in its endeavor to alleviate the sub-standard housing for its low-income families, and

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of March, 1963, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council amended Ordinance No. 47, and

WHEREAS, agreements providing for leasing of land are now required to enable the Housing Authority to proceed with construction of mutual aid housing with assistance of the Public Housing Administration of the Housing and Home Finance Agency.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to execute land lease agreements for 150 selected sites for construction of Mutual Help Housing dwelling units for a nominal fee of one dollar (\$1.00) per year per site for the term of 25 years together with an option for an additional 25 years.

The foregoing resolution was on February 26, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
