

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Chambers and Associates have made preliminary study relative to the construction of a winter sports facility and ski run on the Mount Ord area, and

WHEREAS, said preliminary report contains sufficient information to justify the expenditure of funds to make an engineering and feasibility study within the said Mount Ord area for the construction of a winter sports facility and ski run.

WHEREAS, the Tribe does not have sufficient funds to spend for said purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby directed to request the sum of \$21,400.00 from Area Redevelopment Administration in order to make an engineering and feasibility study of the Mount Ord area to determine the economic practicability of constructing a winter sports facility and ski run in the Mount Ord ski area.

The foregoing resolution was on February 26, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended and Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
