

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to establish per diem rates for all Tribal Employees except contract employees, Tribal Council, Chairman and Secretary, thereof, and


WHEREAS, the Council desires to increase the per diem rate of Tribal Employees while camping out on the job and on the reservation.


BE IT RESOLVED that any employee of the Tribe, except contract employees, Tribal Council, Chairman and Secretary thereof, when off the reservation and within the State of Arizona shall be considered in a travel status and shall be reimbursed at a per diem rate of \$15.00 in lieu of subsistence and lodging, and when outside of the State of Arizona, \$17.00 in lieu of subsistence and lodging computed in accordance with Government Travel Regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all Tribal Employees when camping on the reservation and on duty shall be paid the sum of \$4.00 per diem.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Controller is hereby instructed to prepare a memorandum of the Government Travel Regulations and to furnish same to all of the said Tribal Employees.

The foregoing resolution was on March 19, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
