

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it has become apparent to the Council that more coverage for new risks is needed in its Insurance Program, due to the ever-expanding operations of the various Enterprises, and

WHEREAS, competition among the various Insurance Agents has produced a sound Insurance Plan at reasonable cost from a reliable agent, and

WHEREAS, the Faust Insurance Company of Globe, Arizona, as a result of open competition has offered the best program.

BE IT RESOLVED that the proposal of the Faust Insurance Company of Globe, Arizona is hereby accepted for consolidating all Tribal Insurance under a single blanket coverage.

The foregoing resolution was on April 15, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
