

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, for some years last past, Rustin Cheney has failed to properly irrigate the orchard which had been assigned to him, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Police Department and the White Mountain Apache Tribal Farm Cooperative desire to use said lands.

BE IT RESOLVED that the assignment of the Agency Orchard on Orchard Ditch in North Fork District, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, containing approximately 6.52 acres issued to Rustin Cheney on the 5th day of October, 1960 is hereby revoked.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said acreage is hereby assigned to the White Mountain Apache Tribal Police Department and the White Mountain Apache Tribal Farm Cooperative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the residence located on the premises is to be either removed or enclosed by a fence and in either event, the residence is to remain the personal property of Rustin Cheney.

The foregoing resolution was on April 16, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
