

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the timber in the Tribal Sawmill Block, East Fork drainage, in the next logical area for harvesting by the Fort Apache Timber Company.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Elk Canyon Logging Unit in East Fork presented in the Forest Officer's Report and recommended by the Area Forester on May 23, 1964 be approved with the following volumes and valuations:


