

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is necessary that certain portions of the Fort Apache Reservation Timber reserves be inventoried and appraised in order to guarantee a continual supply of timber for the respective sawmills located on the said reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED that inventory and appraisal work be commenced on the following proposed logging units:

Block	Unit	Annual Cut, MMBF
West	Deer Springs	7.7
North Fork	McKay No. 3	4.8
North Fork	Coulter No. 3	4.7

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon completion of these studies the appraisal be submitted for approval by this Council.

The foregoing resolution was on May 27, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
