

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Mount Ord area has a great potential for a ski run and other winter sports, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe would like to develop said area as a winter sports area, and
- WHEREAS, in order to justify any expenditures for developing the area, it is necessary to have a feasibility study made.
- WHEREAS, the cost of the feasibility study is the sum of \$25,000.00, and
- WHEREAS, the Government will provide 90 percent of the cost of the study provided the Tribe appropriates ten percent of the cost of the said study.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$2500.00 is hereby appropriated from Tribal funds for the purpose of providing ten percent of the cost of a feasibility study on and in the vicinity of Mount Ord to determine the advisability of an investment to develop the area as a winter sports area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Government is hereby requested to furnish an additional sum of \$23,500.00 which is necessary to defray the entire cost of the said study.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are hereby authorized to sign any and all necessary documents to consummate the feasibility study.

The foregoing resolution was on May 28, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
