

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 62-76 the Tribe granted to the Bureau of Reclamation authority to have access to the Fort Apache Indian Reservation for carrying out surveys and investigations relating to hydrologic and engineering studies for the development of dams, reservoirs, waterways and appurtenant works, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has received information that the Bureau of Reclamation might recommend that certain water emanating from the reservation might be diverted therefrom.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 62-76 is hereby rescinded in toto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribe is hereby authorized to arrange for another meeting with the Bureau of Reclamation to determine exactly what projects the Bureau desires to make studies on and to report to the Council the minutes of the said meeting with the Bureau of Reclamation.

The foregoing resolution was on May 2 , 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) and (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
