

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe is now operating many facilities in its diversified business and Tribal Government, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe and its employees, in many instances, are not covered by public liability or property damage insurance, and

WHEREAS, it is good business to have said coverage.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Controller and Tribal Treasurer are hereby directed to negotiate with insurance companies to secure public liability and property damage insurance coverage for all Tribal and Enterprise employees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Controller and Treasurer present to the next Tribal Council meeting their recommendations.

The foregoing resolution was on January 8, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
