

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it appears that various accounts for maintenance funds in the Tribal Budget for the fiscal year 1963-64 will need funds in addition to amounts originally anticipated in order to protect and preserve material reservation resources, and

WHEREAS, there has been savings in various other accounts which are more than sufficient to provide the above-required additional funds.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council that the Tribal Budget for the Fiscal Year 1963-64 be amended by transferring \$1200.00 from 64-133 (Maintenance Man's Salary) to 64-134 (Irregular Maintenance Labor ) and by transferring \$350.00 from 64-136 (Janitor's Wages) to 64-137 (Maintenance Materials).

The foregoing resolution was on May 28, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). /
