

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there has been interest shown in leasing the K & M Mine, Asbestos mine on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, it should be advantageous to the Tribe to lease the said claims.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Phoenix Area Director of the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby requested to advertise those certain asbestos mining claims, the description of same being on file in the Superintendent's office, Fort Apache Indian Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
