WHEREAS, the Tribal Construction Enterprise is heavily indebt, and


WHEREAS, the Construction Manager has agreed to submit to the Tribal Council a new Plan of Operation for said Enterprise, said plan to show the economic feasibility of said enterprise.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$77,000.00 is hereby appropriated from tribal funds to be used for the purpose of paying all accrued accounts payable of the White Mountain Construction Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on July 9, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and by-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
