

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is of utmost importance that the membership roll be brought up to date, and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to employ a secretary and to purchase sufficient office supplies to effectuate this purpose.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is appropriated from Tribal Funds in the sum of \$3564.00 to establish a GS-3, Step 1 Position to do the necessary Secretarial work and to furnish the supplies to bring the membership roll up to date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that savings in the amount of \$600.00 be made from Section I H (5), 65-130 and \$2964.00 from Section VII, G (4) to pay the said Secretary and purchase the office supplies necessary to effectuate the completion of the membership roll.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Secretary is to be under the supervision of the Tribal Secretary.

The foregoing resolution was on August 12, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (K) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
