

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, under paragraph (a), Resolution No. 63-153 specifies, among other things, that the minimum rate per M.B.F. shall be \$5.00 for Douglas Fir, and

WHEREAS, the correct advertised rate for Douglas Fir should be \$5.60 per M.B.F., and

WHEREAS, the \$5.00 figure is a typographical error.

BE IT RESOLVED that paragraph (a), Resolution No. 63-153 is hereby amended to change the figure of \$5.00 per M.B.F. for Douglas Fir to the figure \$5.60 per M.B.F.

The foregoing resolution was on January 8, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
