

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the St. Anthony Catholic Church Missionary of McNary, Arizona has set aside to it a 2½ acre tract of land as a site for mission operations among the Indians and residents of that town, and

WHEREAS, the said Catholic Church Missionary desires to exchange said 2½ acres of ground for another 2½ acre parcel located within the same vicinity, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to approve said exchange.

BE IT RESOLVED that the following described 2½ acres of land is set apart as a site for mission operations among the Indians and residents of McNary, Apache County, Arizona, TO-WIT:

Beginning at a point 25 feet East and 30 Feet South of the center line intersection of Fir Street and McQuatters Avenue.

Thence East along South boundary of Fir Street 410.6 feet, thence South or right angles of Fir Street 262.5 feet to the North right of way line of Highway No. 73, Thence West along said right of way line 410.6 feet, Thence North along East boundary line of McQuatters Avenue 268.5 feet to point of beginning making an area of 2-1/2 acres in the town of McNary, Apache County, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior rescind the order (L-S55837-2739205-27 - December 14, 1927) setting aside the following described land for the Catholic Mission operations among Indians at McNary, Arizona:

Beginning at a point approximately 80 feet north of the south line of Pine Avenue in the town of McNary, where it is joined on the South line of Springerville Highway and the east line of 5th street; thence 150 feet east to the southwest corner of the proposed site; thence north 375 feet; thence east 458.5 feet; thence south 99 feet; thence southwesterly along the north line of Springerville Highway 535 feet to the point of beginning, containing approximately 2.5 acres, in Apache County, Arizona .

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council and/or the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency are hereby authorized to execute a 25 year lease on the land at the rate of \$1.00 per year.
