

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of January, 1963, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council adopted Ordinance No. 47 establishing a Housing Authority on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in its endeavor to alleviate the sub-standard housing for its low-income families, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 63-32 appointed the Commissioners of the Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 64-75 is an error as pertains to Section 4, ORGANIZATION, Paragraph 1 (a) of Ordinance No. 47.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 64-75 provide that John W. Lee should be appointed for a two-year term in violation of Section 4, Paragraph 1 (a) of Ordinance No. 47, instead of a four-year term.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 64-75 is hereby rescinded and Mr. John W. Lee of Whiteriver, Arizona is hereby appointed for a term of 4 years as a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Housing Authority, beginning May 17, 1964 and ending May 16, 1968, pursuant to the Ordinance which created the Housing Authority on January 16, 1963.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for, and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
