

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe has a Girls Youth Camp located on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation commonly known as the Williams Creek Camp, and


WHEREAS, Congress has recently passed the Economic Development Act of 1964 which, among other things, will establish Job Corp Camps, and

WHEREAS, there are a number of interested and eligible White Mountain Apache girls and boys who could attend such camps, and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient conservation work and restoration of antiquities and historical sites on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to provide employment for enrollees of a Job Corp Camp.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent and/or the Chairman are hereby requested to use all of their available means to secure the establishment of the said Job Corp Camp, pursuant to the Economic Development Act of 1964.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
