

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the U. S. Geological Survey desires to install a stream gaging station on Ditch Camp near McNary, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to cooperate with this Agency in making water studies.

BE IT RESOLVED that the U. S. Geological Survey is hereby granted permission to install a stream gaging station on Ditch Camp approximately 200 feet upstream from the McNary Waterline Diversion on Whiteriver in the NE Quarter, SE Quarter, of Section 7, T7N, R26E, Apache County, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
