FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Agency and Tribal personnel and others have prepared a ten-year human and economic resources program, and

WHEREAS, the consummation of the said ten-year program would be a tremendous step forward in making the White Mountain Apaches self-sufficient.

BE IT RESOLVED that the said ten-year program is hereby approved and adopted as the official program of the White Mountain Apaches.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all of the members of the committees who prepared said program is to be congratulated for a job well done.

The foregoing resolution was on September 2, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
