

Resolution No. 64-97

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 64-74 authorized appraised and minimum base rates for the various species on the Elk Canyon Logging Unit for Fort Apache Timber Company, and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 1964, the Area Director conducted a reappraisal of the rates which effected a reduction in the overall stumpage value and recommends the following new rates:

Mexican White Pine	3,400,000	3.75	2.00
Spruce	2,400,000	3.75	2.00
Corkbark Fir	Neg.	3.75	2.00

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 64-74 dated July 9, 1964, be amended to show the new appraised and minimum base rates as shown above and as recommended by the Area Director for the Elk Canyon Logging Unit.

The foregoing resolution was on September 30, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
