


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., purchase of the Maverick Logging Unit, approved July 19, 1943, has on July 30, 1964, applied for authority to cut 4,900,000 board feet of timber in addition to authorized 18,000,000 board foot cut for the year ending March 31, 1965.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. is hereby authorized to cut an additional 4,900,000 board feet of timber for the year ending March 31, 1965 subject, however, to the approval of the Area Director and the Pacific Indemnity Company of Los Angeles, California, the contract surety for Southwest Forest Industries, Inc.

The foregoing resolution was on September 30, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
