

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Canyon Creek No. 1 Logging Unit, approved July 17, 1962, is scheduled to complete cutting September 30, 1964, and to complete all other conditions of said contract on or before December 31, 1964, and


WHEREAS, this unit was estimated to contain 15,000,000 board feet and purchaser, Western Pine Sales, Inc. has cut approximately 12,000,000 board feet, and


WHEREAS, the unit will exceed by a several million board feet the original 15,000,000 board feet estimate, and

WHEREAS, the purchaser by letter on July 14, 1964, requested an extension of time to cut the remaining volume.

BE IT RESOLVED that the purchaser be granted a time extension for the above-mentioned unit for the completion of cutting and other obligations to December 31, 1965, but be charged \$1.00 per 1,000 board feet in addition to the regular stumpage rate for each 1,000 board feet remaining to be cut on September 30, 1964, to meet the original 15,000,000 board foot estimate.

The foregoing resolution was on September 30, 1964 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
