

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Overall Economic Development Program Committee has advised the Council that there are many qualified Apaches who could be trained in the construction trades, and

WHEREAS, the said committee has proposed a training and instruction operations program under the Area Redevelopment Act and/or M.D.T.A.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council fully approves the above proposal for training in the construction trades and hereby directs the Chairman for and on behalf of the Tribe to execute any and all requests necessary to effectuate the establishment of said training program on the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
