WHEREAS, Mr. Roy Lewis hauls logs and timber for Chlarson & Reidhead Lumber Company, and

WHEREAS, Chlarson & Reidhead Lumber Company has a timber and milling contract in the Cibecue area, and


WHEREAS, Roy Lewis desires to construct a garage and welding shop in the Cibecue district.

BE IT RESOLVED that the said Roy Lewis is to furnish to the Superintendent and the Chairman, a plat of the land desired to be leased by Roy Lewis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an appraisal be made of the said land.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is authorized to execute for and on behalf of the Tribe a lease of said land for a period not to exceed five years and at a yearly rental of not less than the appraised value thereof.

The foregoing resolution was on January 6, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
