

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise is owned and operated by the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise sells Arizona State Hunting and Fishing licenses at its various retail outlets, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Game and Fish Commission requires that the Enterprise carry a bond in the amount of \$20,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Enterprise is herewith authorized to obtain the aforementioned bond and maintain said bond as long as it acts as a Game and Fish license dealer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Manager of the said Enterprise is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said bond.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
