

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 65-8 adopted January 7, 1965, the Tribal Council in effect attempted to amend the plan of operation of the Revolving Credit Program by providing that a member of the Tribal Council could serve on the Credit Committee, and

WHEREAS, the Area Director of the Bureau of Indian Affairs strongly advised against amending the said ordinance.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 65-8 is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Gus Quintero is hereby appointed as a committee member of the Revolving Credit Program for a period of three (3) years beginning January 1, 1965 and ending December 31, 1967.

The foregoing resolution was on February 11, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
