

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was of the opinion that it had made application to the Federal Housing Administrator to authorize the building of 30 low rent houses on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent has advised the Council that it is necessary to refile an application.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman, the Superintendent, and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority are hereby requested and directed to make application to the proper governmental agency for the building of thirty (30) low rent houses on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on February 11, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
