

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there are distributed free of charge to tribal members, approximately 1,200 copies of the "Apache Scout", and

WHEREAS, if the Tribe paid for these subscriptions the Tribe could secure additional advertisers for the "Apache Scout", and

WHEREAS, this would increase the income needed for publication of the "Apache Scout", and

WHEREAS, Wade Cavanaugh has been classified as an employee of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and is therefore entitled to the health and accident insurance benefits that other tribal employees receive, and

WHEREAS, an incentive plan covering the securing of advertising would promote the sale of more advertising for the "Apache Scout".

BE IT RESOLVED that the budget committee is hereby instructed to provide the sum of One Thousand Seven Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$1,700.00) in the "Apache Scout" budget for the purchase of not in excess of 1,700 subscriptions to the "Apache Scout", said subscriptions to be mailed to the heads of families and other members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, said sum to be budgeted in Fiscal Year 1965-1966.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribe reimburse Wade Cavanaugh for one-half the cost of the health and accident insurance policy premiums as paid by the said Wade Cavanaugh from the 1st day of November, 1963 to the 28th day of February, 1965.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribe will pay Ten Percent (10%) commission to any person who secures advertising for the "Apache Scout" provided, however, that no commission shall be paid for advertising secured from tribal enterprises.

The foregoing resolution was on February 11, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
