

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 64-108, October 28, 1964, authorized the Five-Year Timber Sales Program which included in the schedule the Forestdale Pulpwood No. 1 Logging Unit to be offered for sale after completion of the Cooley Mountain Pulpwood Logging Unit, and

WHEREAS, the Forestdale area is in excessively rough ground which would curtail operations during the rainy and winter seasons.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Gooseberry Pulpwood Logging Unit be appraised and offered for bids in lieu of the Forestdale Pulpwood No. 1 Logging Unit.

The foregoing resolution was on March 4, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
