

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, each individual member of the Tribal Council, together with the Bureau of Indian Affairs representatives, have met with all of the different communities on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation relative to arriving at the preferences under the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, and

WHEREAS, the said communities considered many facets of the act, and

WHEREAS, the Council listed all of the preferences and voted to establish the said preferences.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe authorizes and directs the Chairman to sign all application blanks and any other necessary documents to enable the Tribe to participate under the said Economic Opportunity Act of 1964.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following programs and their preferences in chronological order are hereby established for the White Mountain Apache Tribe, to wit: 1. Pre School Program. 2. Adult Education. 3. Coordinators. 4. Recreation, Physical fitness. 5. Elementary Counselling. 6. Child Care. 7. Apache Culture Center. 8. Trachoma Eradication. 9. Resident Nurse.

The foregoing resolution was on March 25, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
