

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, under certain programs of the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 it will be necessary to house personnel to carry out the functions of the act, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to participate in the said act.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe will provide not more than nine housing units for teachers under the pre education program or for other necessary personnel to carry out the approved projects under the Economic Opportunity Act.

The foregoing resolution was on March 25, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
