

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has in the past unanimously agreed to participate
in the 1964 Economic Opportunity Act, and

WHEREAS, Project Headstart, United States Government Form 3 will greatly
benefit the children residing on the reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Superintendent are hereby directed
and requested to sign any and all documents necessary to effectuate
the said Project Headstart on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on March 25, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 6
for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe,
pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended
Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
