

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Sport Fisheries, Alchasy Fish Hatchery Division has requested the Tribe of 100 cubic yards of cinders from the McNary Cinder Pit to be used on lands being leased by the said fish hatchery all on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe will be benefited by the improvement of the area to be surfaced with said cinders.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized to grant to the said Bureau of Sport Fisheries, Alchasy Fish Hatchery Division 100 cubic yards of cinders from the McNary Cinder Pit on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation at no charge.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Superintendent are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the release of said cinders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cinders shall be used on or before one year from the date hereof.

The foregoing resolution was on March 26, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
