

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the North Fork District has for a long period of time requested funds to construct a community building in their area, and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee approved the sum of \$20,000.00 for the construction of said building, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe's available money budgeted is acute.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and the Superintendent request that an application be filed immediately with the Home and Finance Agency, Community Facilities, Paul Emert, Administrator, for the government to contribute its legal share for the construction of said community building.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the U. S. Government fails to participate that the said \$20,000.00 be reallocated for the construction of the North Fork Community Building.

The foregoing resolution was on March 26, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
