

Resolution No. 65-56

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 65-23, the Tribe granted the authority to issue permit to the Arizona State Highway Department for gravel and borrow at specified prices stated therein, and


WHEREAS, the Arizona State Highway Department has pleaded with the Tribal Council to reduce the price of said cinders commensurate with the prices the Highway Department is paying other suppliers.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 65-23 is hereby amended by providing that the prices to be changed for the removal of said gravel and borrow as follows, to-wit:

Three Cents (3¢) per ton for all borrow, Six Cents (6¢) per ton for all select, ABC, MA; and Ten Cents (10¢) per ton for all screenings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all the other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 65-23 shall remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on April 7, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
