


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Penrod Mountain Burn Logging Unit contract, Eldon Stratton, Purchaser, approved August 19, 1964, was authorized a time extension for cutting and payment from December 31, 1964, to May 31, 1965, by Resolution No. 64-128 and approved by Assistant Area Director, George W. Hedden January 22, 1965, and

WHEREAS, due to unprecedented snowfall during the past winter, roads are yet impassable for logging vehicles; the Purchaser has on April 15, 1965, applied for a second extension for completion of cutting and payment and other obligations from May 31, 1965, to September 30, 1965.

BE IT RESOLVED that the completion date of the above-mentioned contract as specified above be extended from May 31, 1965, to September 30, 1965, and that all other terms of the contract remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on April 28, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
