

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 62-12 certain Livestock Associations were authorized to purchase cattle off the reservation, and

WHEREAS, a committee consisting of certain named persons was appointed to inspect all cattle proposed to be purchased off the reservation, and

WHEREAS, it was the intention of the Council that the positions held by these said committee men instead of the persons themselves were to be named.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 62-12 is hereby amended by providing that the following named persons holding the respective positions are named as a committee to inspect and approve all cattle to be purchased off the reservation for use on the reservation to-wit:

White Mountain Tribal Herd Board Chairman
Tribal Herd Manager
Livestock Manager
General Livestock Board President
Brand Inspector
Land Operations Officer

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all of the terms and conditions of Resolution No. 62-12 shall remain in full force and effect except as herein modified.

The foregoing resolution was on April 28, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
