WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe recognizes that certain aspects of the Plan of Operations of the White Mountain Construction Enterprise are no longer economical feasible, and


WHEREAS, research and study has indicated that a smaller scale operation under competent management is economically feasible,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Plan of Operations for reorganization and operation of the enterprise is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the enterprise are hereby authorized and directed to continue the operation under the name of the White Mountain Concrete and Gravel Enterprise in accordance with the approved Plan of Operations for reorganization and operation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of the Plan of Operations which by reference is made a part hereof be forwarded through proper channels for Bureau approval.

The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
