

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Post Office Department Rental Agreement for the Whiteriver Post Office building has expired as of March 31, 1965, and

WHEREAS, the Post Office Department has requested an extension to be added to the present Post Office building and a renewal of the Rental Agreement, and

WHEREAS, an estimate has been made of the cost of the extension with a subsequent appraisal of rental value, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 65-49 approving the tribal budget, funds were provided and approved by the Area Director for the extension.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to execute a lease or permit for a period not to exceed twenty-five (25) years, including an option, with the Post Office Department at a rental rate of not less than \$125.00 per month on the Whiteriver Post Office building after the extension is built.

The foregoing resolution was on May 12, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
