

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Maverick Logging Unit Contract, Southwest Forest Industries, Inc., purchaser, has stumpage rates per thousand board feet for the second quarter 1965 as follows:

<u>Ponderosa and Mexican White Pine</u>	<u>Douglas Fir</u>	<u>Spruce</u>	<u>White and Corkbark Fir</u>
\$7.54	\$8.33	\$3.00	\$1.50

, and

WHEREAS, Acting Deputy Assistant Commissioner George W. Mathis, requested on September 29, 1964, recommendations as to whether the alternative method of adjustment of stumpage values should be initialed from the current quarterly procedure, and

WHEREAS, by a log grade study by the Agency forestry staff and study and computations by the Area Forester, new rates have been determined and reviewed in consultation with the purchaser in accordance with the contract and which were recommended by the Area Director on May 28, 1965, as shown below.

BE IT RESOLVED that new stumpage and base rates per thousand board feet are recommended on an annual basis as follows for the Maverick Logging Unit:

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
