

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Federal Government has approved a sum in the amount of \$390,704.00 to finance the Neighborhood Youth Corps of the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is required, under the law, to contribute ten percent of this sum as and for its share of the cost of the project, and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that for payroll taxes, vehicle rental and for playground equipment, the sum of \$36,969.00 will be needed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$36,969.00 is hereby appropriated out of Tribal Funds on deposit with the Government to be used for the following purposes and amounts:

Payroll taxes on 490 children	\$24,081.00
Vehicle Rental	6,888.00
Playground Equipment	<u>6,000.00</u>
	\$36,969.00

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
