

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Dr. John Konnak has exemplified himself as Officer in charge of the U. S. Public Health Service Hospital, Whiteriver, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, under his supervision, the White Mountain Apaches' health standards have been greatly improved, and

WHEREAS, the Whiteriver Hospital, for the first time, is now an accredited institution, and

WHEREAS, said Dr. John Konnak is now terminating his services at Whiteriver.

BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby expresses its deep appreciation for the splendid work performed by Dr. John Konnak and wish him great success in his profession.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (a) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
