

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of January, 1963, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council adopted Ordinance No. 47 establishing a Housing Authority on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in its endeavor to alleviate the sub-standard housing for its low-income families, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 63-32 appointed the Commissioners of the Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hal Butler's term as Commissioner expired May 16, 1965, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hal Butler has served the Housing Authority in an outstanding manner.

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority Committee must consist of five members.

BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. Hal Butler of P. O. Box 447, Show Low, Arizona, is hereby reappointed for a term of four years as a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Housing Authority.

The foregoing resolution was on June 2, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
