

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department was granted a right of way varying in width from 200 feet to 400 feet, a distance of 6.06 miles in the Forestdale area, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 65-53 adopted on April 7, 1965 granted this right of way subject to the condition precedent that the Arizona Highway Department conveys, transfers and assigns all of the present lands west of the proposed new alignment to the Tribe, which lands will not be needed by the Arizona State Highway Department, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Highway Department has notified the Tribal Council that they intended to utilize the old road, with new turnoffs from the realignment for access to a proposed roadside park as shown on the application for additional right of way.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Arizona Highway Department be granted the use of this area for new turnoffs and a roadside park as delineated on the maps on file in the Office of the Superintendent, Fort Apache Indian Agency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 65-53 is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the condition precedent that the Arizona Highway Department conveys, transfers and assigns all of the present lands west of the proposed new alignment to the Tribe, which lands the Tribe assumes would not be needed by the Arizona State Highway Department and which condition was made part of the said Resolution No. 65-53 prior to the issuance of the said new right of way by the Tribe to the State.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should the said areas not be used for a roadside park that it shall revert to the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all of the other terms and conditions of Resolution No. 65-53 shall remain in full force and effect.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
