FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Williams Creek and Alchesay National Fish Hatcheries desires 1200 yards of cinders for use on the roads within the fish hatcheries areas, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe would benefit by the improvements in the roads.


BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent and/or the Tribal Chairman are hereby authorized to issue a 1200 yard gratuitous cinder permit to the Williams Creek and Alchesay National Fish Hatcheries for use on the roads leading to and from the fish hatcheries.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cinders are to be mined from the pit behind Cooley Hill.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
