

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, surplus game animals exist on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Game Wardens and the Tribal Recreation Board has recommended that permits be issued to non-members to harvest said game animals, and

WHEREAS, the revenues derived from the sale of permits to non-members will be beneficial to the Game Management Program.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached recommendations for non-member hunting during the 1965-66 season be approved.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1965 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
